

Governor Ivey released her amended Safer At Home Order on June 30, 2020, and is valid through July 31, 2020, until 5:00 p.m. Following the Alabama Department of Public Health's recommendations and the Order of the State Health Officer, the courthouse will continue to require wearing face coverings to enter the building because social distancing through security will be difficult to maintain. Temperature checks will continue before entry into the courthouse. Each department head will decide what safety measures will be taken based on each department's ability to accommodate social distancing.
