NOTICE OF JOB VACANCY

Department with Vacancy: **Road Department**

Job Title: **Equipment Operator III – District 2 (West Side)**

Schedule and Grade for Position: Monday-Thursday 6:00 am – 4:30 pm
Occasional Overtime may be required. Must be able to work non-standard hours, including holidays and weekends, if required.
Grade 6 Step TBD

Position Description: The employee is responsible for operating all types of heavy equipment in the performance of road and bridge construction and maintenance activities. May perform manual labor. Other duties as required.

Requirements for Position: Must possess:

- Ability to operate a motor grader, backhoe, front-end loader, tar truck, excavator, etc. as well as other equipment such as steel wheel roller, soil pan, chip spreader, scraper, sidewinder, bulldozer, light and heavy dump truck and tractor.
- Ability to perform safety and maintenance inspections of assigned equipment and monitor gauges and other indicators for non-standard conditions while equipment is being operated.
- Ability to perform light maintenance and servicing such as adding fluids and greasing moving parts.
- Ability to perform strenuous manual labor, including (but not limited to) operating a chain saw, using axe, bush axe and saw to clear brush; loading and unloading heavy construction materials, shoveling asphalt, dirt, rocks, etc.; installing and cleaning drainpipes.
- A Class "A" CDL or the ability to become certified within set time limit.
- A driving record that meets standards set by the county's insurance carrier.

This is a "safety-sensitive" position. Successful candidate must pass a pre-employment physical and drug test and will be subject to random unannounced drug testing throughout employment with the County in a "safety-sensitive" position.

Education: Must possess a high school diploma or equivalent and at least 3 to 4 years' experience in operating heavy equipment; however, any combination of education and experience will be considered.
