NOTICE OF JOB VACANCY

Department with Vacancy: **Road Department – Bridge Crew**

Job Title: **Skilled Bridge Construction and Maintenance Trainee**

Schedule and Grade for Position: Full-Time Position
Occasional Overtime may be required. Must be able to work non-standard hours, including holidays and weekends, if required.
Grade C4, Step To Be Determined (based on qualifications and experience)

Position Description: The employee is responsible for performing work in bridge construction and maintenance. Drives flat bed and dump trucks to work sites to deliver supplies and equipment. Performs carpentry work, welding, concrete forming and various skilled labor tasks under supervision and training by other Skilled Bridge Construction and Maintenance personnel. Other duties as required.

Requirements for Position: Must possess:

- Ability and willingness to learn basic skills in the operation, maintenance and safe use of trucks, tractors and other related equipment
- Ability and willingness to learn carpentry, concrete work and welding as related to bridge construction and maintenance activities.
- Ability to perform manual labor, including (but not limited to) digging under bridges, grading for flumes, removing rocks from work areas and draining standing water from roads. Lifting and carrying fifty (50) pounds or more of equipment and/or materials, maneuvering up and down streambanks, slopes or other changes of elevation, working from a low profile position (kneeling, bending, squatting, etc.). Requires above average agility and dexterity.
- A Class “A” CDL or the ability to become certified within one year of employment in this position.
- A driving record that meets standards set by the county’s insurance carrier.

This is a “safety-sensitive” position. Successful candidate must pass a pre-employment physical and drug test and will be subject to random unannounced drug testing throughout employment with the County in a “safety-sensitive” position.

Must possess a high school diploma or equivalent. Experience in construction and maintenance including operation of equipment preferred; however, any combination of education and experience which provides the characteristics listed above will be considered.
