Commissioner Yarbrough made the motion to approve the minutes from the August 30, 2012 Commission Meeting, approve appropriations, expenditures, requisitions, travel expenses and approve all journal entries to be posted. ### Ratify appointment of members to the Duck River Advisory Committee

Chairman Graves explained the water systems involved in purchase of water from the City of Cullman will make up the Duck River Advisory Committee. The committee will have input during the building of the dam and the payment period of the bond issue. Once the bond issue is retired, each water system will have ownership in the reservoir based on their water usage.

Attorney Culpepper announced the first meeting of the Advisory Committee will be Monday, September 17, 2012 in the EMA Office meeting room. This first meeting will be an organizational meeting for the adoption of by-laws and the election of officers. The meeting is open to the public.

Commissioner Hicks made a motion to ratify the appointments to the Duck River Advisory Committee. Commissioner Yarbrough seconded the motion which passed on a unanimous voice vote.

## Consider renewal of the Workers' Compensation Insurance with ACCA for 2012-2013

Gary Teichmiller, County Administrator, stated this past year the County has had a good record on workers' comp claims and as a result the premiums for the insurance for next year have not gone up. Commissioner Yarbrough made a motion to approve the renewal of the Workers' Compensation Insurance with the ACCA. Commissioner Hicks seconded. The motion passed on a unanimous voice vote.

## Consider a Rock Removal Lease between Marigold Land Company and Cullman County Commission

Commissioner Yarbrough explained the lease will allow the County to obtain needed rock without cost except of fuel and labor. Commissioner Hicks made a motion to approve the rock removal lease between Marigold Land Company, a Drummond subsidiary, and Cullman County. Commissioner Hicks seconded. Upon a unanimous voice vote, the motion passed.

## Ratify a \$4,800 appropriation for the Cullman County Community Concert Association

Commissioner Yarbrough made a motion to ratify a \$4,800 appropriation to the Cullman County Community Concert Association. Commissioner Hicks seconded the motion which passed on a unanimous voice vote.

## Ratify a \$5,000 appropriation to the Oktoberfest 2012 Committee

Commissioner Hicks made a motion to ratify a \$5,000 appropriation to the Oktoberfest 2012 Committee. Commissioner Yarbrough seconded. The motion passed on a unanimous voice vote.

## Ratify a \$2,500 appropriation to the Chamber of Commerce

Commissioner Yarbrough made a motion to ratify a \$2,500 appropriation to the Chamber of Commerce. Commissioner Hicks seconded the motion which passed on a unanimous voice vote.

#### Resolution 2012-43 - CARTS Third Party Service Contracts - FY 2013

Joyce Echols, CARTS Director, stated the resolution authorize the Chairman to sign the authorization for CARTS to obtain third party service contracts for FY-2013. This year there were six contracts and for 2013 there will be eleven. Commissioner Yarbrough made a motion to approve the resolution. Commissioner Hicks seconded. Upon a unanimous voice vote, the motion carried.

#### Resolution 2012-44 – Regarding the Adoption of a Portion of County Road 386 into the County Road System

Attorney Culpepper explained the section of county road under consideration is a dead-end road past the boat launch at Smith Lake. In 1996-97 residents attempted to donate this portion of County Road 386 to the County. However, the road was never accepted into the county maintenance system and no work has ever been performed by the county. The current residents are now requesting this remain a private road. The purpose of this resolution it to clarify that the described portion of the road is not in the maintenance system; however the County does reserve the easements where utilities have been placed.

Commissioner Yarbrough made a motion to approve the resolution clarify the status of County Road 386. Commissioner Hicks seconded the motion which passed on a unanimous voice vote.
