

**CULLMAN COUNTY COMMISSION  
EMERGENCY CALLED MEETING  
December 26, 2015**

Chairman Walker called the Emergency Meeting to order at 10:00 for the purpose of declaring a Local State of Emergency due to widespread flooding in Cullman County. The County has received in excess of 10" of rain in the past 24 hours resulting in the closing of numerous roadways and bridges. Several bridges and roads are totally washed out and more rain and damaging winds are forecast for Monday of next week. A number of residential homes have been flooded with some families losing everything.

Present were Chairman Kenneth Walker; Commissioner Kerry Watson; Phyllis Little, EMA Director; Scott McDonald, Assistant EMA Director and County Attorney Chad Floyd. Commissioner Garry Marchman was absent. Tim Collins from *Cullman Today* was in attendance. Tiffany Owens from *The Cullman Times* was notified of the meeting.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to declare a Local State of Emergency effective December 23, 2015. Chairman Walker seconded and the motion carried on a unanimous voice vote.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to adjourn and Chairman Walker seconded. The meeting was adjourned.
