SUBJ: Winter Weather Road Conditions

To minimize confusion, the Cullman County EMA is recommending that the following phrases be used in describing local road conditions during winter weather events. By using the same phrases, all departments, agencies, etc. will have the same understanding of road conditions and information given out to the public will be consistent.

Key Phrase

Definition

Advisory

Motorists are advised to use extreme caution when traveling.

During winter weather this often means that overpasses, bridges, and roadways at higher elevations are beginning to freeze or are covered with snow. Traffic is moving but with difficulty. Accidents have occurred. **Non-essential travel discouraged.**

Impassable

Vehicular travel is prohibited on this roadway due to unsafe roadway conditions. Emergency response personnel are engaged in other response activities and are unable to install road closure devices at this time. All non-emergency travel strongly discouraged.

During winter events this means that many areas are blocked because of accidents. Traffic is at a stand still in some areas. All non-essential businesses and industry are encouraged to consider shift delays or closing during this time. *AL State Troopers may not be writing accident reports when roads are deemed impassable. Local law enforcement policy will determine whether or not reports will be written by local officers.*

Closed

NO traffic permitted on this roadway except for emergency response and law enforcement. During winter events this means that roads must be blocked by barricades and have signs designating "Road Closed." No travel authorized. Vehicles will be ticketed.

Interstate highways, U.S. and State routes can only be closed by Alabama State Troopers. County roads may be closed by the County Commission with jurisdiction. Municipal or city streets may be closed by the Mayor and/or City Council with jurisdiction.
