SmartFusion Employee Self-Service

As an employee of Cullman County Commission you are eligible to utilize the SmartFusion Employee Self-Service (ESS) Website. You can login to the website and create an account by following the steps below:

Enter Employee ID, Social Security #, an Email address, and set your password – then click Register. After you register, a notice will automatically be sent to Personnel who will activate your account. You will also receive an email confirmation sent to the address you used to set up the account. Once your account in activated you will be able to login using the link above. Enter the email address and password you used when setting up the account.

Once you have signed up and entered the site, ESS will allow you to:

- Leave Tab:
 - View current leave balances for sick and vacation time (as of last payroll run)
 - View the leave totals you have taken YTD (as of last payroll run)

• Pay Tab:

- View your bi-weekly pay information
- View your YTD pay information for the current and past year.
- View your W-2 Form (beginning with the 2018 W-2)
- View your direct deposit information
- View your federal tax withholding information

• Personal Information Tab:

- View personal information such as address, e-mail and phone numbers
- View job title and hire date

The State of Alabama Employees' Retirement System (ERS) was established in 1945 to provide benefits to state employees, state police, and on an elective basis to qualified persons of counties, cities, towns and other quasipublic organizations. Cullman County Commission has elected to participate in the ERS by providing retirement benefits to all qualified Cullman County employees.

There are currently two separate active member groups in the ERS with two separate benefit levels, however Cullman County Commission has elected to grant our Tier 2 employees the same benefits as the Tier 1 employees.

ERS Tier 1 Active Members – Any member of the ERS who had service credit with the ERS prior to January 1, 2013

ERS Tier 2 Active Members – Any member of the ERS who had no service credit with the ERS prior to January 1, 2013

The purpose of this deferred compensation 457(b) plan is to allow Cullman County employees to establish a supplement retirement account. You may create an account with Nationwide by completing all necessary paperwork (available in the Personnel Department) and returning completed forms to Payroll.

Once you have established your Nationwide account you can register online at <u>www.NRSforU.com</u> This website allows easy 24/7 web access to your account.



Supplemental Insurance

Cullman County Commission offers a variety of supplemental benefits to our employees. These benefits include Whole Life and Term Life Insurance, Cancer Insurance, Accident Insurance, Disability Insurance, etc. Employees can sign up or make changes to the supplemental plans during the annual open enrollment period which takes place in the month of November (with changes effective the following January 1st. Below is a list of the companies we have a payroll deductible relationship with. All of these companies maintain a web access allowing you to go online and set up a login to be able to view and manage your accounts.

As an employee of Cullman County, you may be eligible for an **18% discount** as a member of the Alabama Government Employees Group

To sign up for this discount:

- Or you can complete the "Discount Eligibility Form" online if you do not have a county email address.





AT&T gives Cullman County employees a **17% discount** on the monthly service charge of qualified wireless plans.

AT&T/Direct TV gives Cullman County employees a **15% discount** on the monthly service charge of qualified wireless plans. Plus, get \$300 in credits when you switch to AT&T, buy a smartphone on AT&T Next and trade in a smartphone.



GoodRx is a great way to help save money on your prescriptions and the best thing is that it's completely FREE to use for your whole family. Check GoodRx every time you get a prescription to see your possible savings.

Follow these EASY STEPS to get started:

- Step 1: Download the GoodRx app on the iTunes and Google Pla App stores OR – visit <u>www.goodrx.com</u>.
- Step 2: Price your medication (Make sure to double check dosage and quantity information.
- Step 3: Locate the pharmacy offering the lowest price for your prescriptions....OR... select the coupon you want.
- Step 4: Be sure to show your GoodRx card (see below) or coupon to the pharmacy before they scan your medication at check out.



Everyone can use GoodRx, whether they are enrolled in BCBSAL insurance or not. While you cannot combine GoodRx with your insurance to lower your cost, it may be cheaper than the coinsurance in your current benefits.
