

**Resolution 2025-09**  
**SUPPLEMENTAL RESOLUTION FOR EXPENDITURE OF AMERICAN RESCUE**  
**PLAN ACT FUNDS**  
**FOR COURTHOUSE VENTILATION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, Cullman County, Alabama (the "County") has received American Rescue Plan Act fiscal recovery funds ("ARPA funds") and is charged with ensuring that such funds are expended in accordance with state and federal law; and

**WHEREAS**, ARPA funds may be used for ventilation projects designed to mitigate and prevent COVID-19 in public buildings ("eligible COVID-19 ventilation projects"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Cullman County Commission (the "Commission") has identified, with assistance from an independent consultant, an eligible COVID-19 ventilation project at the Cullman County Courthouse ("the project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has determined that using ARPA funds to cover the reasonable costs of the project is a necessary, eligible, and reasonable use of these funds; and

**WHEREAS**, by way of Resolution 2022-24, the Commission approved the expenditure of ARPA funds to cover design costs of the project; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with applicable state and federal competitive procurement requirements, the Commission entered into a contract with JMR+H to provide architectural services related to the implementation of the project ("the contract"); and

**WHEREAS**, the project was let for bid in accordance with applicable state and federal law; and

**WHEREAS**, by way of Resolution 2023-12, the Commission allocated up to \$3,385,000.00 to cover construction costs relating to the project and entered into a contract with Stateline Mechanical, LLC to perform construction services; and

**WHEREAS**, the throughout the course of construction due to unforeseen circumstances, multiple change orders were needed, resulting in an increase of costs attributable to the project; and


**WHEREAS**, the Commission has determined that it is reasonable and prudent to cover additional costs of this project using ARPA funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION** as follows:

1) The Commission allocates up to \$3,694,405.01 of the County's ARPA funds to cover reasonable costs relating to the project, including design and construction costs. This allocation is inclusive of the allocations made in Resolutions 2022-24 and 2023-12 cited to herein.

2) Expenditure of the funds allocated herein, shall be contingent on ongoing compliance with applicable state and federal procurement requirements, as well as the continued appropriation and availability of ARPA funds for this purpose. In no event shall funds allocated herein be used for any costs

**SUPPLEMENTAL RESOLUTION FOR EXPENDITURE OF AMERICAN RESCUE**  
**PLAN ACT FUNDS**  
**FOR ELIGIBLE WATER PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, Cullman County, Alabama (the "County") has received American Rescue Plan Act fiscal recovery funds ("ARPA funds") and is charged with ensuring that such funds are expended in accordance with state and federal law; and

**WHEREAS**, ARPA enumerated uses funds may be used for certain water and sewer infrastructure projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cullman County Commission (the "Commission") has identified, with assistance from an independent consultant, an eligible water infrastructure project at the Trade Tank Pump Station, ("the Trade Tank Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with applicable state and federal competitive procurement requirements, as approved by Resolution 2023-22, the Commission entered into a contract with Goodwyn Mills and Cawood to provide engineering services related to the implementation of eligible water and sewer infrastructure projects, including the Trade Tank Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the project was let for bid in accordance with applicable state and federal law; and

**WHEREAS**, bids for the purchase of materials for the Trade Tank Project were received on December 9, 2024, with Consolidated Pipe and Supply Company, Inc. supplying the lowest responsive bid; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has determined the Commission has determined that using ARPA funds to cover the reasonable costs, including design and construction costs, of the project is a necessary, eligible, and reasonable use of these.

funds **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION** as follows:

1) The Commission allocates the remainder of its ARPA enumerated uses funds or \$341,245.13, whichever is higher, to cover reasonable costs relating to the project, including design and construction costs. The remainder of the costs to be covered by other legally available funds including, ARPA funds designated as "revenue replacement" funds.

2) The Commission hereby approves the contract for the purchase of pipe to Consolidated Pipe and Supply Company, Inc. consistent with the invitation to bid and the bid received therefore.


3) The County Administrator is hereby authorized to expend the County's ARPA funds for costs associated with design and materials for the project from the vendors identified herein.

4) Expenditure of the funds allocated herein, shall be contingent on ongoing compliance with applicable state and federal procurement requirements, as well as the continued appropriation and availability of ARPA funds for this purpose. In no event shall funds allocated herein be used for any costs



associated with the project that are not obligated on or before December 31, 2024 and expended on or before December 31, 2026.

**FOR EXPENDITURE OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS**  
**FOR WATER DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, Cullman County, Alabama (the "County") has received American Rescue Plan Act fiscal recovery funds ("ARPA funds") and is charged with ensuring that such funds are expended in accordance with state and federal law; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has duly elected, as prescribed by the U.S. Department of Treasury's final rule, to designate \$10,000,000 of its ARPA funds as revenue replacement funds ("ARPA revenue replacement funds"); and

**WHEREAS**, ARPA revenue replacement funds may be used to facilitate the provision of government services traditionally provided by the County, like funding operational costs of the County Water Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cullman County Commission (the "Commission") has identified, with assistance from an independent consultant, water infrastructure project at the Trade Tank Pump Station, ("the Trade Tank Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has determined the Commission has determined that using ARPA funds to cover the reasonable operational costs of the Water Department, including reasonable costs associated with the Trade Tank Project, is a necessary, eligible, and reasonable use of these; and

**WHEREAS**, all operational costs will be procured in a manner that is consistent with the state Competitive Bid Law or Public Works Law, as applicable, and Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards, as applicable to the expenditure of ARPA revenue replacement funds.

funds **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION** as follows:

1) The Commission allocates the remainder of its ARPA revenue replacement funds or \$412,445.02, whichever is higher, to cover reasonable operational costs of the Water Department. This allocation specifically includes, but is not limited to the following:

- a. costs of the Trade Tank Project not covered by other ARPA enumerated uses funding;
- b. Purchase a pipe for replacement projects


2) The allocation of funds herein is conditioned upon the successful and proper procurement of goods and services consistent with state and federal laws and regulations and the ARPA terms and conditions.

3) The County Administrator is hereby authorized to expend the County's ARPA funds for costs associated with design and materials for the project from the vendors identified herein.

4) Expenditure of the funds allocated herein, shall be contingent on ongoing compliance with applicable state and federal procurement requirements, as well as the continued appropriation and

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025 – 06**

This Resolution is made this **28th** day of **October, 2024** (the Effective Date) as an amendment to the resolution made on the 10th day of **December, 2021** (Abatement Start Date) by the **City of Cullman, Alabama** (the Granting Authority), to grant a tax abatement for **Schulte Building Systems/Inland Southern** (the Company). This resolution is amended to show that **Schulte Building Systems/Inland Southern** has changed their capital investment figure from **\$3,350,000** to **\$4,000,000** and extend the abatement period from the 30th day of **June, 2023** to 1st day of **May, 2025** .

WHEREAS, the Company has announced plans for a (check one): new project or **XX** major addition to their existing facility (the Project), located within the jurisdiction of the Granting Authority; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tax Incentive Reform Act of 1992 (Section 40-9B-1 et seq., Code of Alabama 1975) (the Act), the Company has requested from the Granting Authority an Abatement of (check all that apply):

- all state and local noneducational ad valorem taxes,
- all construction related transaction taxes, except those construction related transaction taxes levied for educational purposes or for capital improvements for education, and/or
- all mortgage and recording taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Company has requested that the abatement of state and local noneducational ad valorem taxes (if applicable) be extended for a period of **10** years, in accordance with the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Granting Authority has considered the request of the Company and the completed application (copy attached) filed with the Granting Authority by the Company, in connection with its request; and

WHEREAS, the Granting Authority has found the information contained in the Company's application to be sufficient to permit the Granting Authority to make a reasonable cost/benefit analysis of the proposed project and to determine the economic benefits to the community; and

WHEREAS, the construction of the project will involve capital investment of **\$ 4,000,000** , and

WHEREAS, the Company is duly qualified to do business in the State of Alabama, and has powers to enter into, and to perform or observe the agreements and covenants on its part contained in the Tax Abatement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Granting Authority represents and warrants to the Company that it has power under that constitution and laws of the State of Alabama (including particularly the provisions of the Act) to carry out provisions of the Tax Abatement Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Granting Authority as follows:

Section 1. Approval is hereby given to the application of the Company and abatement is hereby granted of (check all that apply):

- all state and local noneducational ad valorem taxes;
- all construction related transaction taxes, except those construction related transaction taxes levied for educational purposes or for capital improvements for education, and/or
- all mortgage and recording taxes;

as the same may apply to the fullest extent permitted by the Act. The period of abatement for the noneducational ad valorem taxes (if applicable) shall extend for a period of 10 years measured as provided in Section 40-9B-3(h) of the Act.


Section 2. The governing body of the Granting Authority is authorized to enter into an abatement agreement with the Company to provide for the abatement granted in Section 1.

Section 3. A certified copy of this resolution, with the application and abatement agreement, shall be forwarded to the Company to deliver to the appropriate local taxing authorities (if applicable) and to the Alabama Department of Revenue in accordance with the Act.

Section 4. The governing body of the Granting Authority is authorized to take any and all actions necessary or desirable to accomplish the purpose of the foregoing of this resolution.

# Tax Abatement Agreement

This agreement is made this **27th** day of **October, 2024** (the Effective Date) as an amendment to the resolution made on the **10th** day of **December, 2021** (Abatement Start Date) by the **City of Cullman, Alabama** (the Granting Authority), to grant a tax abatement for **Schulte Building Systems/Inland Southern**(the Company) This resolution is amended to show that **Schulte Building Systems/Inland Southern** has changed their capital investment figure from **\$3,350,000** to **\$4,000,000** and extend the abatement period from the **30th** day of **June, 2023** to **1st** day of **May, 2025** .

WHEREAS, the Company's North American Industry Classification System Code 326199 , meets the qualifications of an industrial or research enterprise in accordance with Section 40-9B-3(f), **Code of Alabama 1975**, as amended

WHEREAS, the Company has announced plans for a (check one)

new project or **XX** major addition to their existing facility (the Project),

located within the jurisdiction of the Granting Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Project was estimated to be completed by **30<sup>th</sup>** day of **June, 2023**; but now is estimated to be completed by **1st** day of **May, 2025** and

WHEREAS, the Project will be located in the County of **CULLMAN** (check whichever is applicable)

- inside the city limits of **THE CITY OF CULLMAN** ;
- inside the police jurisdiction of **THE CITY OF CULLMAN** ;
- outside the city limits and police jurisdiction of the City of **CULLMAN** ; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tax Incentive Reform Act of 1992 (Section 40-9B-1 et seq., **Code of Alabama 1975**) (the Act), the Company has requested from the Granting Authority an Abatement of (check all that apply):

- all state and local noneducational ad valorem taxes,
- all construction related transaction taxes, except those construction related transaction taxes levied for educational purposes or for capital improvements for education, and/or
- all mortgage and recording taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Granting Authority has considered the request of the Company and the completed applications filed with the Granting Authority by the Company, in connection with its request; and



WHEREAS, the Granting Authority has found the information contained in the Company's application to be sufficient to permit the Granting Authority to make a reasonable cost/benefit analysis of the proposed project and to determine the economic benefits to the community; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting held on the 27th day of **October, 2024** (the Meeting), the Granting Authority approved the Company's application for abatement of (check all that apply):

- all state and local noneducational ad valorem taxes,
- all construction related transaction taxes, except those construction related transaction taxes levied for educational purposes or for capital improvements for education, and/or

all mortgage and recording taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Project will consist of private use industrial development property, which is composed of all real and related personal property to be acquired, constructed, and installed thereon, as described in Attachment One hereto; and

WHEREAS, the private use industrial development property for which the abatement is applied shall be (check whichever is applicable):

- owned by the entity applying for the abatement,

leased from a public authority, municipal, or county government; and

WHEREAS, in the event that the private use industrial development property is leased from a public authority, municipal, or county government, the lessee shall be treated as the owner of such property for federal income tax purposes; and

WHEREAS, it shall be indicated whether the Granting Authority intends to issue bonds in connection with the private use industrial development property herein described, and, if so intends, shall attach a copy of the inducement agreement; and,

WHEREAS, for the purposes of abatement of all noneducational ad valorem taxes (if applicable), it has been determined that no portion of the Project has been placed in service or operation by the Company or by a related party, as defined in 26 U.S.C. §267, with respect to the Company prior to the Effective Date of this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Project conducts trade or business as described in any of the following 1987 Standard Industrial Classification Major Groups 20 to 39, inclusive 50 or 51, Industrial Group Number 737, or Industry Numbers 0724, 4613, 8731, 8733, or 8734, as set forth in the Standard Industrial Classification Manual published by the United States Government Office of Management and Budget; and

WHEREAS, if the Project is a major addition to an existing facility, the request for abatement of all state and local noneducational ad valorem taxes (if applicable) and/or all construction related transaction taxes (if applicable) does not include any capitalized repairs, rebuilds, maintenance, replacement equipment, or costs associated with the renovating or remodeling of existing facilities of industrial development property previously placed in service by the Company; and

WHEREAS, if the Project is a major addition to an existing facility the addition equals the lesser of (i) thirty (30) percent of the original cost of the industrial development property, or (ii) \$2,000,000; and

WHEREAS, the Company is duly qualified to do business in the State of Alabama, and has powers to enter into, and to perform and observe the agreements and covenants on its part contained in this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Granting Authority represents and warrants to the Company (a) that it has power under the constitution and laws of the State of Alabama (including particularly the provisions of the Act) to carry out provisions of the Agreement, (b) that the execution of this Agreement on its behalf has been duly authorized by resolution adopted by the governing body of the Granting Authority;

NOW THEREFORE, the Granting Authority and the Company, in consideration of the mutual promises and benefits specified herein, hereby agree as follows:

1. In accordance with the Act, the Granting Authority hereby grants to the Company an abatement from liability for the following taxes as permitted by the Act (check all that apply):

(a) Noneducational Ad Valorem Taxes: all ad valorem taxes that are not required to be used for educational purposes or for capital improvements for education;

(b) Construction Related Transaction Taxes: the transaction taxes imposed by Chapter 23 of Title 40 of the Code of Alabama 1975 on the tangible personal property and taxable services to be incorporated into the Project, the cost of which may be added to capital account with respect to the Project, except for those local construction related transaction taxes levied for educational purposes or for capital improvements for education;

(c) Mortgage and Recording Taxes: all taxes imposed by Chapter 22 of Title 40 of the Code of Alabama 1975 relating to mortgages, deeds, and documents relating to issuing or securing obligations and conveying title into or out of the Granting Authority with respect to the Project.

2. An estimate of the amount of tax abated pursuant to this Agreement is set forth below. The Granting Authority and the Company hereby acknowledge that this estimate reflects the amount of tax abated for the period stated, under current law, and that the actual abatement of such taxes may be for a greater or lesser amount depending upon the actual amount of such taxes levied during the abatement period as stated. (Check all that apply)

(a) If no bonds are to be issued, noneducational ad valorem taxes are expected to be approximately \$ **14,400** per year and the maximum period for such abatement shall be valid for a period of **10** years, beginning with the October 1 lien date next proceeding the acquisition date of abated property.

(b) If bonds are issued, noneducational ad valorem taxes are expected to be approximately \$ \_\_\_\_\_ per year and the maximum period for such abatement shall be for a period of \_\_\_\_\_ years, beginning the initial date bonds are issued to finance.

(c) Construction related transaction taxes, except those construction related transaction taxes levied for educational purposes or for capital improvements for education, are expected to be approximately \$ **120,221** and such abatement shall not extend beyond the date the Project is placed in service.

(d) Mortgage and recording taxes are expected to be approximately \$ \_\_\_\_\_

3. The Company hereby makes the following good faith projections:

(a) Amount to be invested in the Project: **\$4,000,000;**

(b) Number of individuals to be employed initially at the Project and in each of the succeeding three years:

Initially 0 Year 1 0 Year 2 0 Year 3 0;

(c) Annual payroll initially at the Project and in each of the succeeding three years:

Initially \$0 Year 1 \$0 Year 2 \$0 Year 3 \$0;

4. The Company shall file with the Alabama Department of Revenue within 90 days after the date of the Meeting a copy of this agreement as required by Section 40-9B-6(c) of the Act.

### GENERALLY

5. Compliance. If the Company fails to comply with any provision in this Agreement or if any of the material statements contained herein or in Attachment Two (*Note: This attachment shall include the application for abatement*), are determined to have been misrepresented whether intentionally, negligently, or otherwise, the Granting Authority shall terminate this Agreement and take such equitable action available to it as if this Agreement had never existed. If it is determined that certain items, which are identified on the application form for abatement of taxes, are not in compliance with the Act or governing regulations, these items may be subject to taxation for all local and state taxing authorities.

6. Binding Agreement. Each party to this Agreement hereby represents and warrants that the person executing this Agreement on behalf of the party is authorized to do so and that this Agreement shall be binding and enforceable when duly executed and delivered by each party. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of each of the parties and their representative successors.

7. Limitations. Notwithstanding any provision contained herein to the contrary, this Agreement is limited to the abatement of (check all that apply):

all state and local noneducational ad valorem taxes.

all construction related transaction taxes, except those construction related transaction taxes levied for educational purposes or for capital improvements for education, and/or

all mortgage and recording taxes fees for the periods specified herein. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as a waiver by the Company of any greater benefits that the Project or any portion thereof may have available under provisions of the law other than the Act.





ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH SERVICES  
AGENCY GRANT AGREEMENT  
Fiscal Year 2023 – 2024

The Alabama Department of Youth Services hereby awards to

**Cullman County Commission**  
(Fiscal Agent, hereinafter called Recipient)

the amount of **Seventy-nine thousand six hundred eighty and no/100 dollars (\$138,619.00).**

These funds shall be used for non-residential diversion services for **Blount County** youth who would otherwise be committed to the Alabama Department of Youth Services (DYS). Based on youth needs, the **Blount County Juvenile Court (BCJC)** will develop or collaborate in the development of a diversion program, which may include the identification and selection of community providers. As a result of the interventions funded by these monies and based on the estimates provided in the grant application, the parties expect that this program will provide diversion services to 6 youth annually with an ongoing capacity of 3 youth at any given time. Thereby aiding in a reduction of county commitments to DHS (including CLIMB, formerly known as HIT), barring a significant increase in serious juvenile crime (i.e. violent felonies, felony sex offenses). To assist juvenile courts in the provision of services for children in need of supervision (CHINS), DHS will permit the program to provide diversion services to no more than 10% of youth with CHINS offenses.

These funds shall be utilized for the following purpose/activities:

*The Blount County Youth Advocate Program (YAP) is a community-based program that stems on working in concert with the family, the community, and other referring agencies to develop and implement individualized service plans and assessments. Service plans include strength-based practices, the wraparound approach, family group conferencing and positive youth development. Each youth is assigned a supportive adult role model or advocate. Youths that are eligible to work are assisted with job seeking skills and transportation to secure and maintain employment.*

The program that receives funding from this grant will:

- Serve youth who would have historically been committed to the Alabama Department of Youth Services (CLIMB or regular DHS) in the absence of the funded program. Specifically, this includes youth with the following characteristics:
  - Males / Females between the ages of 12 – 17
  - Delinquent youth with a medium to high risk of re-arrest, as determined by the risk assessment instrument available on the DHS website
- Be developed by or in collaboration with the **Blount County Juvenile Court (BCJC)**.
- Conduct regular self-evaluations of program effectiveness, including evaluations that track outcomes for children served by the program (GIMS outcome measures).
- Maintain data on program participants as required in the DHS Grantee Information Management System database (GIMS) on a monthly basis.
- Produce an annual report for the October - September fiscal year by utilizing the form available on the DHS website. Each such completed annual report shall be made available to the Alabama Department of Youth Services by November 30. Decisions about renewing grants may be made based on the courts' ability to show through these reports that the funds have been effective in diverting youth from commitment to DHS or CLIMB.



To ensure fiscally responsible management of state funds, quarterly evaluative criteria are integral to the diversion grant funding process. These criteria include, at a minimum, program adherence to youth capacity, annual numbers, average length of stay, and successful completion rates. At any given time within a quarter, program population numbers will be reviewed. If at the time of review the total number of youth reported in the GIMS is below 50% of the maximum capacity, an initial warning will be provided. If a subsequent review during the following quarter indicates that the program population remains below 50% maximum capacity, the program may receive a 25% reduction in funding for the following quarter(s). Program and/or designated court representatives will be given an opportunity to explain the low population numbers. However, final reduction determinations will be made by DYS administration.

Both the **BCJC** and DYS acknowledge that this Award may be terminated at will by the **BCJC** or DYS for any reason. Any funds remaining from the award shall be returned to DYS upon the termination of said award.

The grant award contained herein is payable in installments, subject to the availability of funds and adjustments by the Alabama Department of Youth Services, as it deems necessary or advisable. All parties agree that prior year funds may be available to fund this program and have and/or will be applied to the total grant award. Any unexpended grant fund amounts shall be reported to DYS no later than November 1st. Nothing contained herein shall be deemed to be a debt of the State of Alabama in the contravention of the laws and constitution of the State of Alabama.

By signing this agreement, the contracting parties, including sub-contractors, agree that representatives of the Department of Youth Services will conduct site visits (both announced and unannounced), and that all records pertaining to the program, including financial records will be made available for review. At a minimum, these records would include: court referrals, JPO reports, service plans, progress notes and termination summaries.

The Recipient or its designee shall administer the services for which this grant is awarded, in accordance with the grant application, and applicable rules, regulations and conditions as set forth by the Department. This agreement is for a one-year period and may be extended for an additional year. Nothing contained herein shall be deemed to be a debt of the State of Alabama in the contravention of the laws and constitution of the State of Alabama.

By signing this contract, the contracting parties affirm, for the duration of the agreement, that they will not violate federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, a contracting party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the agreement and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom.
